Dear Parents,

As Cafeteria Manager, I would like to welcome your child/children to the 2020-2021 school year at Mississinawa Valley Schools. The cost of school lunches this year will be as follows: \$2.15 for students PK-8th grade, \$2.30 for students in 9th-12th grades and \$2.50 for adults. Extra milk will be \$.50. Breakfast for everyone is \$1.00. I would like to encourage families to put lunch money into their child/children's account by using payforit.net. If you already have an account set-up online, your username and password will remain the same. If you have forgotten the password, there is an option for "forgot password" on the payforit.net site. Also, you may go to the site to register as a new user (you will need the lunch account # which is also the same as their student id). It is simple and allows you to check your child/children's balance throughout the year and add money anytime you wish. You can also view what lunch items your child is purchasing each day. This is a free service to you, and we encourage everyone to take advantage of it.

Free and reduced lunch forms will be available soon on the school website at www.mississinawa.k12.oh.us (click on cafeteria on the left side of the screen). You may print the form from there, fill out and return to school. You may also pick up a form in the school office prior to school starting. Please be sure to fill out the form correctly to ensure we can process it in a timely manner. If you qualify for a free or reduced lunch, you will also qualify for a free or reduced breakfast. Reduced breakfast price is \$.30 per day and reduced lunch price is \$.40 per day. Breakfast is served daily between 7:30 – 8:00 am. Please encourage your child to each a tasty breakfast at school and help them get a good start to a day of learning!

We hope to avoid students having to charge for breakfast or lunch. If an instance should come up that this happens, a child that pays full price is allowed to charge up to \$10.00. A child that pays the reduced price will be able to charge up to \$2.00. A child that receives a free lunch will not be permitted to charge. If a child in grades K-6th grade reaches their maximum charge amount, they will receive a complimentary milk and peanut butter sandwich. If a child in 7th-12th grade reaches maximum charge amount, they will receive a complimentary peanut butter sandwich. We aim for every child to receive a full lunch and hope any family that might qualify for a free or reduced meal will fill out the form and return to school as soon as possible. We are here for the good of the students and want to be sure they all have what they need to be successful at school!
